The Early Childhood Approach (ECA) approach supports children aged 0-8 years who have a disability or developmental delay and their parents, carers, and families.

Benevolent Society is the NDIS Partner in the Community delivering the ECA approach to Moreton Bay, Brisbane, Logan and Redlands.

As part of the approach, our multidisciplinary allied health team are delivering a series of informal developmental information sessions to families and invite you to attend.

For parents, carers, and families, the information sessions are an opportunity to:

- Better understand your child's support needs and development;
- Learn strategies and receive tools that will promote their development;
- Have your developmental questions answered by our team; and
- Develop a peer support network.

Child Health Service

Birth to five years drop-in clinics

The Child Health Service offers a **free** parenting support service for families with children aged from birth to five years.

Some clinics are for babies from birth to 3 months and others are for children aged up to 5 years. The clinics offer a **brief consultation** with a child health nurse to talk about any issues or concerns you are having. Interpreter services are available where required.

No appointments are required for these clinics and all are open between **9am and 12pm** (midday) on specified days (closed on public holidays). Our Mount Ommaney clinic also opens 12:30 to 3pm on Thursdays. There may be a wait during busy times.
